I. The Search Screen

1. Start by entering a search term(s). In this example, the keywords censorship and FCC have been entered.

2. Click Search to start Academic Search Premier.

Click on Advanced Search to view more search options.

Check this box to limit your search to only peer-reviewed* journals.

- Multi-disciplinary database
 - Covers many subject areas including: computer sciences, engineering, physics, chemistry, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, ethnic studies and many more.
- Indexes over 8,500 journals and magazines.

Full-text

- Over **4,500 journals** are available in full-text
