Dear New Stony Brook Student,

As part of our comprehensive alcohol prevention program, Stony Brook University requires all new first-year students to complete AlcoholEdu for College - an on-line, non opinionated alcohol prevention course. It uses science-based research to educate students about alcohol and its effects. You should have received information about this program in your bag at orientation (or you will once you attend orientation).

The course has two sections, both of which must be completed as part of your Undergraduate College 101 course:

- Part I of the course takes roughly 2.5 hours to complete. You can go in and out of the website to do so, and we recommend that you take it in multiple sittings. This section ends with a short Exam, and Survey # 2. You must earn a grade of **75%** or higher to pass and receive credit for the course. If you fail the exam you will be guided into a retake section of the course. **The course is currently available and the deadline for finishing this section of the course is on Friday, September 4.**
- About one month after you complete the short Exam and Survey 2, you will receive an email asking you to complete Part II. **The deadline to complete Part II is November 1, 2009.**

Log-in Instructions:

- I. Go to: <http://college.alcoholedu.com/login.aspx>
- II. Under New User, Login the following: **9C196097FIRSTYEAR**
- III. On the registration page you will have the opportunity to create your AlcoholEdu for College account **using your Stony Brook ID** and an email address and password of your choice. **If you do not enter your 9-digit SBU ID, you will not receive credit for taking this course.** Make sure that you log into your e-mail account regularly so that you do not miss any important communication from the course or from the University regarding the course.
- IV. You may log in and out of the course at the end of each section. Section ends are marked with a "Next" button. **DO NOT log out until you click the "Next" button or you will have to repeat the section you have just gone through.**
- V. When you return, log in as a Returning User and enter the same email address and password you created when you first logged into the course.

Please note that First-Year students will complete both parts of AlcoholEdu as one of their First-Year Seminar 101 assignments. All survey responses are strictly confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as whole and will never see individual students' responses.
