Dear New Stony Brook Transfer Student,

As part of our comprehensive alcohol prevention program, Stony Brook University **encourages** all new transfer students to complete AlcoholEdu for College - an on-line, non opinionated alcohol prevention course. It uses science-based research to educate students about alcohol and its effects. You should have received information about this program in your binder at orientation (or you will once you attend orientation).

The course has two sections:

- Part I of the course takes roughly 2.5 hours to complete. You can go in and out of the website to do so, and we recommend that you take it in multiple sittings. This section ends with a short Exam, and Survey # 2. You must earn a grade of 75% or higher. The course is currently available and the deadline for finishing this section of the course is on Friday, September 4.
- About one month after you complete the short Exam and Survey 2, you will receive an email asking you to complete Part II. The deadline to complete Part II is November 1, 2009.

Log-in Instructions:

- I. Go to: <http://college.alcoholedu.com/login.aspx>
- II. Under New User, Login the following: **9C196097TF**
- III. On the registration page you will have the opportunity to create your AlcoholEdu for College account **using your Stony Brook ID** and an email address and password of your choice. Make sure that you log into your e-mail account regularly so that you do not miss any important communication from the course or from the University regarding the course.
- IV. You may log in and out of the course at the end of each section. Section ends are marked with a "Next" button. DO NOT log out until you click the "Next" button or you will have to repeat the section you have just gone through.
- V. When you return, log in as a Returning User and enter the same email address and password you created when you first logged into the course.

**Please note that Transfer Student participation is strongly encouraged, but not required.** The information that is contained in the program is useful to all students - regardless of their age or use of alcohol. All survey responses are strictly confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as whole and will never see individual students' responses.
