Abstract Instructions: The abstract should be ~ 300-400 words in length and **MUST BE APPROVED by your faculty research supervisor**. To indicate faculty approval, please copy your research supervisor on the email submission, and ask your mentor to either sign/initial the paper copy, indicating approval, or to notify Karen Kernan (by email or phone) that the abstract has been approved.

Be sure to include: **1) title of research project; 2) author & co-author(s) names** (use full names, and include relevant lab colleagues/research group, such as grad students/ post docs, and faculty supervisor; and **3) department(s)** in which the work was carried out. *If research was conducted off-campus, be sure to indicate the research institution where your work was done (e.g. Brookhaven National Labs, name of university, etc.). **Underline the names of all undergraduate co-authors.*** The abstract should also recognize any funding sources. For example, "This work was supported with funding from Undergraduate Research & Creative Activities (URECA)." Tables or graphs may be included if they are relevant and appropriate to the discipline.

Please submit the abstract texts **VIA EMAIL AND PAPER**. That is,
